### **Army Notes:**

Per Army Directive 2011-20 dated 14 OCT 11, any Army organization seeking to sponsor or co-sponsor a conference or seminar must now receive prior approval from the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army's (AASA) office.

The Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management (OACSIM) has submitted a request to the AASA, but until this

request is approved, Army employees are prohibited from registering for PDS or making any travel arrangements to attend the seminar.

Any individuals violating this directive will be personally liable for these costs. OACSIM will send out notifications once an answer from the AASA is received.
